

- \* How does the director create a sense of mystery and power around Rick before we ever see his face?
- \* What do you think is the significance of Rick playing chess?
- \* How does Rick handle the man from the Deutsche Bank?

## Letters of Transit

- Note the lighting on Ugarte: he appears shiny with grease or perspiration. Compare this to the lighting on Rick: cool, shadowy etc.
- \* Homework: look up the definition of 'oleaginous'.
