# Hiding

- Laszlo and Carl appear in Rick's. They had to flee the resistance meeting, and Laszlo is hurt.
- Rick makes an excuse to get Carl alone, and asks him to take Ilsa home.
- Carl is surprised to see her standing in the shadows, but agrees to do as Rick asks.
- We can contrast this with the scene in which Rick asked Sacha to take Yvonne home. He did the right thing then, but only because he is a decent man. This time, he loves the woman he is sending away.

# Appearance versus Reality

- Rick comes down to the bar to talk to Laszlo.
- Rick's reflection shows him surrounded by all the paraphernalia of a barman. Is this the real Rick?
- Laszlo is not fooled by Rick's veneer of cynicism. He, like Capt. Renault, believes that Rick is a better man than he lets on.
- Laszlo tells Rick that everyone has their destiny and that we cannot escape that which is in store for us.

#### Sacrifice

- Laszlo knows there is something between Rick and Ilsa.
- He nobly asks Rick to ensure she is taken away safely.
- Laszlo is willing to sacrifice his freedom and his marriage for the woman he loves.
- The police arrive and arrest Laszlo.
- It seems that destiny has taken a hand.'
- Rick is cynical and tough once more.

## A Bargain

- The following morning, Rick goes to Capt. Renault to ask that Laszlo be released.
- He argues that Laszlo's detention is not legal in Unoccupied France.
- Capt. Renault warns Rick not to help Laszlo escape.
- What makes you think I'd stick my neck out for Laszlo?' This is the old, cynical Rick, but we wonder now if it is the real Rick.
- Renault is suspicious. He remembers the bet, he knows Rick doesn't like Strasser, and he knows Rick has the letters of transit.
- Rick admits he does, but says he wants to use them to go to America with Ilsa.
- Rick tells Renault that if he guarantees his and Ilsa's safe escape from Casablanca, he Rick will arrange for him to be able to arrest Laszlo on a serious charge.
- Renault is pleased at the thought.
- \* 'Germany... Vichy, would be very grateful.'

## Preparing to Leave

- Rick is in The Blue Parrot arranging to sell it to Ferrari.
